FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF OUR PARISHIONERS

If you are new to our parish you may not know the following:

1. During Mass if you are unable to walk up for Holy Communion, an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion will circumvent the church with Holy Eucharist. Please stand in your pew or raise your hand and the Minister will stop to give you Holy Communion.
2. The last pew on the Mary Shrine side of the church is reserved for the handicapped. The kneeler has been removed to make it easier for people to move in and out of the pew.
3. There are two restrooms in the back of the church. One is located off the main vestibule and the other is near the back exit on the Mary Shrine side of the church.
