**TRINITY SUNDAY**

**THE BLESSED TRINITY—A Matter of Relationships**

The concept of mystery is very much a preoccupying part of our human nature. Often, we are intrigued by the pleasure of trying to solve mysteries. At other times we are intrigued by the challenge of seemingly unsolvable mysteries.

Matthew 28:16-20 (read on a day which many Christians call Trinity Sunday) places mystery in the essential message of Christianity. Jesus told His disciples to “go to all peoples and baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.” The concept of the Trinity has been mystifying to Christians. But if we look at this mystery from the perspective of relationships with others, then we can get a better, if somewhat limited, understanding of the Divine Mystery of God’s life within the Persons of the Blessed Trinity.

I recently attended two occasions where several of my brother priests and our Bishop were present. On both of these occasions certain priests were acknowledged for reaching their Capital Campaign goals as well as their Diocesan Lenten Appeal goals. They were told that their outstanding leadership has brought about their success.

I wonder how they did it! When it comes to raising money I find myself deficient. However, according to Church Law, I am the chief financial officer of the parish which brings this task to my desk.

I have always been very pleased with the generosity of this parish. **Thank you for your kindness and love for your parish and for supporting me.** We have a little further to go if we wish to make our goals for both these campaigns.

At present, we have raised **\$697,880.00** for the Capital Campaign. Our goal is **\$720,000.00** leaving us **\$22,120.00** needed. I hope that there would be some who would take up this slack for the good of the parish. Money has already come back to us and we will be using it for the upkeep of our parish.

Our **Diocesan Lenten Appeal** goal is **\$57,337.00**. So far we have collected **\$49,035.00** leaving us needing **\$8,302.00** to reach our goal. The money that we receive over our goal would go towards purchasing a new sign for the outside of the church.

During the weekend of June 5 & 6 we will have a "**Commitment Sunday**" in order to bring our **Diocesan Lenten Appeal** to a close. I am counting on your continued generosity to make both campaigns a success.

I wish to again personally thank all those who helped me with the **TCTH Capital Campaign**. This was a lot of work and I could not have done it without them.
