



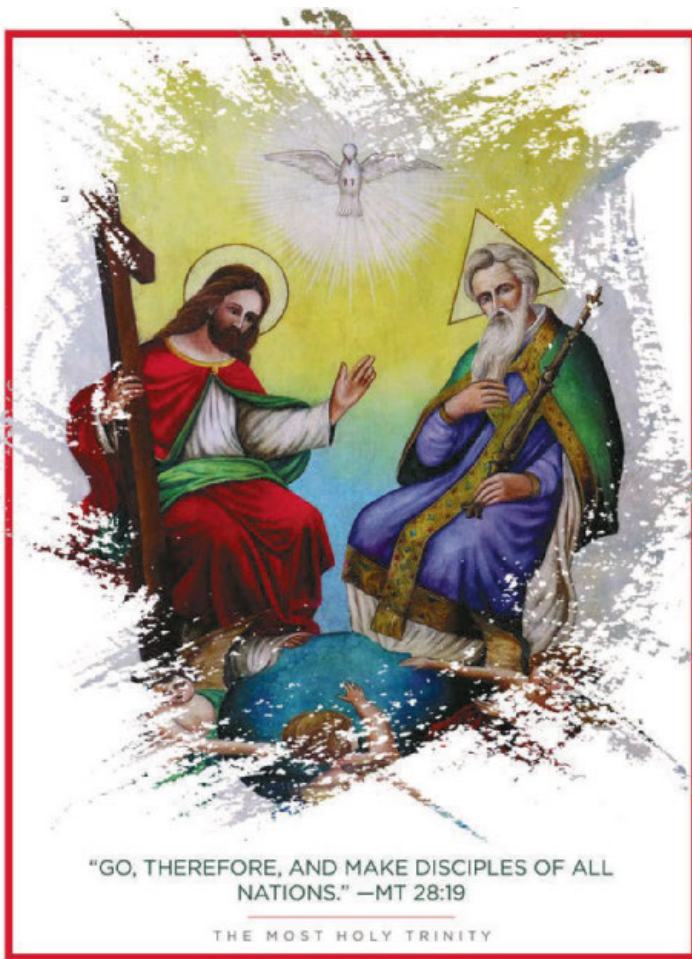

Bishop Kulick to Lead Eucharistic Procession in Greensburg

Bishop Larry J. Kulick will lead a Eucharistic procession from Blessed Sacrament Cathedral to Courthouse Square in Greensburg next Sunday, **June 2**, the Feast of Corpus Christi. The procession will follow the 11 a.m. Mass at the cathedral, which will be celebrated by Bishop Kulick. The feast, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is an annual celebration honoring the institution of the Holy Eucharist, the source and summit of the Catholic faith. Following Mass, the faithful are invited to join Bishop Kulick for the procession. At Courthouse Square, there will be an area for adoration and Benediction. For those unable to walk the distance between the cathedral and Courthouse Square, a shuttle bus will be provided.
